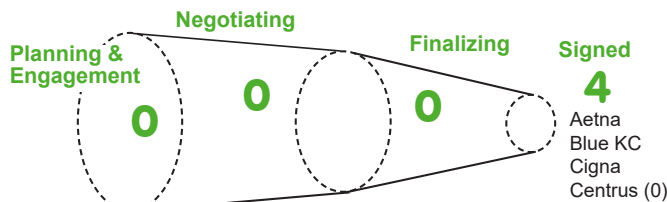

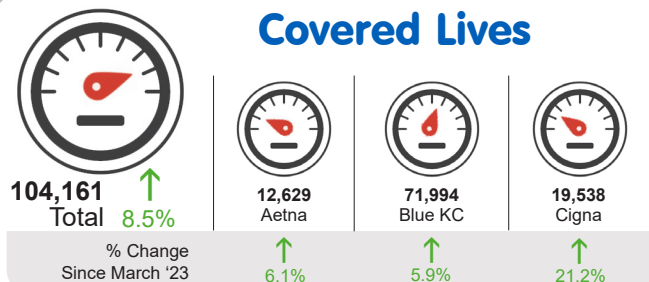
Highlights

- Network exceeded targets in 12 of 12 quality and utilization incentive measures for CY2022 with 4 measures exceeding the national 90th percentile benchmark!
- CMHN earned 100% (approximately \$10.5 million) of available Blue KC Advanced Primary Care Program incentives and nearly \$1 million in shared gains within the Blue KC Total Cost of Care agreement.
- Finalized the CMHN incentive model for CY2023, adding a health equity data collection requirement and pausing distribution of funds into a CMHN reinvestment account.
- Added a new American Board of Pediatrics Part 4 project on SDOH Screening & Referral.
- Completed pilot of a high cost / high utilizer pre-visit planning report. Tactic provided some benefits (increased awareness of acute utilization, costs) but not sufficient value given low impact on incentives or risk mitigation.
- Made the SDOH referral process more efficient and effective by integrating community based organization screeners into Innovaccer's point-of-care solution (InNote).
- Launched a 'Powering Families' Learning Series, a monthly educational live webinar providing caregivers an opportunity to connect with CM experts on topics such as healthy eating, anxiety, safety, and more.
- Advanced Health Equity initiative with multiple tactics, including a PCHM live webinar with Children's Mercy Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion leaders, deployment of a Race, Ethnicity, and Language Training Video, and active participation in the Kansas City Health Equity Learning and Action Network.

Upcoming Activity

- Complete deployment of REL data collection standards. Evaluate health disparities and select health equity improvement project for 2024.
- Deployment of new Innovaccer features, including new high utilizer / high cost indicators, new lab and imaging point-of-care cards, and access to acute ED/IP notes directly at point-of-care.
- ICS to extend our networks to include behavioral health providers, starting with community mental health centers. Goal to launch behavioral health advisory committee by end of 2023.
- Continue HPV vaccination QI efforts, influencing practices to initiate HPV vaccine series at age 9 and perform targeted outreach to 12-13 year old patients in need of 1 HPV vaccine.
- Continue to support and improve social need referrals with 5 community based organizations (CBOs) & other CBOs on the Lift Up KC platform.
- Continue to advance network-level strategies (use of philanthropic funds to support) to help address behavioral health service needs.
- Continue to advance deployment and use of Innovaccer population health management platform.
 - **Primary Care:** Ongoing education and re-engagement to drive care team adoption.
 - **Specialty Care:** Continue effort to partner with specialty divisions to engage in value based strategies by complementing specialty care models with population-based data (quality & cost), increased cross continuum collaboration, and PHM technology.
