Top Recommendations & Tactics to Inform Quality Improvement in 2022

HPV Vaccination

HPV Vaccination Rates 37% Lower than MCV/Tdap

- **Key Tactics:**
 - Consider updating practice standard to recommend the HPV vaccine at age 9 to help patients attain higher antibody levels and start conversations earlier for hesitant parents.
 - If vaccine refused at age 9, offer HPV vaccine bundled with other age 13 vaccinations as a standard of care. Use the FAQ to view the complete list of ADHD medications.
- **Insights:**
 - HPV Vaccine rates vary dramatically between providers within each practice. Use Innovaccer CIN Quality Performance Dashboard to view your vaccination rates compared to your colleagues' rates within your practice.

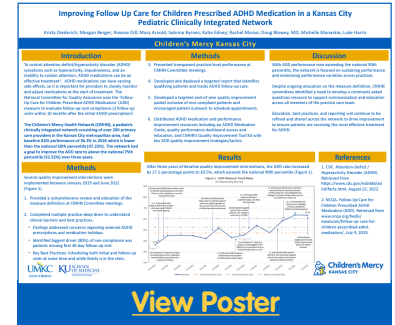

Improving Follow Up Care for Children Prescribed ADHD Medication in a Kansas City Pediatric Clinically Integrated Network

Results: After three years of iterative quality improvement interventions, the Follow up Care for Children Prescribed ADHD Medication rate increased by 27.5 percentage points to 63.5%, which exceeds the national 90th percentile.

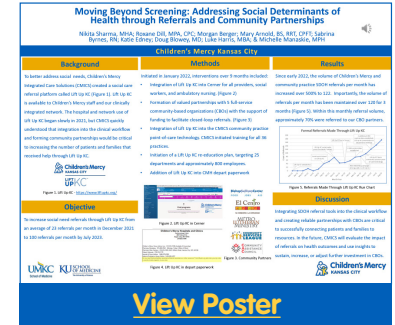

Moving Beyond Screening: Addressing Social Determinants of Health through Referrals and Community Partnerships

Results: Since early 2022, the volume of Children's Mercy and community practice SDOH referrals per month has increased over 500% to 122. Importantly, the volume of referrals per month has been maintained over 120 for 3 months (Figure 5). Within this monthly referral volume, approximately 70% were referred to our CBO partners.



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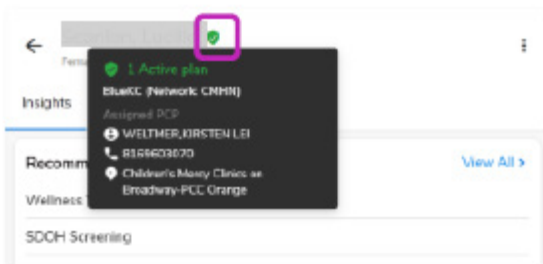

2 **NEW** Network and PCP Practice Indicator



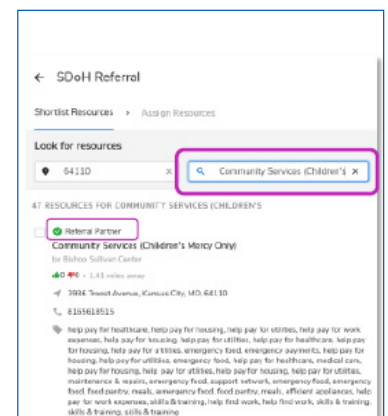
