NEW Chlamydia Screening Pre-Visit Planning Report

- **Report Objective:** Supports pre-visit planning for chlamydia screening for all 'sexually active' female patients with scheduled appointments over next 10 days.
 - Patients only included if they have not had a chlamyida screening in previous 12 months
 - o Aligns with Innovaccer Reccomended Care

Use Case Example: CMH Primary Care currently uses this pre-visit planning report and has seen an increase in their Chlamydia Screening rates. They have designated staff who alert providers each week with a scripted message in Cerner notifying them their patient is due for a Chlamydia Screening.

What is InNote?

- Innovaccer's point of care application that presents **relevant and actionable patient information** as you navigate your EMR.
- InNote brings in claims data from health insurance companies and connects with 40+ community practice EMRs, so you are able to see care that happened at other hospitals and clinics.

3 Educate on Patient 360 (P360)

Click on the patient's name in InNote to access P360. P360 includes **CMH acute visit notes** and additional data on **lab results, immunizations, dispensed medications, and more!**

Goldiloks PRISM Study Information

- Children's Mercy Hospital and Mayo Clinic researchers are conducting a new study for teens ages 12-18 with depression – the GOLDILOKS PRISM Study (Prediction of Response in SSRImanaged Major Depressive Disorder in Adolescents).
- Participants must be:
 - Between 12-18 years old
 - o Diagnosed with depression, and
 - o Prescribed, but not yet started, fluoxetine
- Providers can refer eligible patients via a website, contact the study team directly by phone or email, or give the patient and family a recruitment flyer.
