#### Blue KC

#### Core Measures

- 1. 15 Month Well-Child Visits (6+ visits)
- 2. 3-6 Year Old Well-Child Visits
- 3. HPV Immunization
- 4. Weight Assessment BMI Percentile\*
- 5. Inappropriate Treatment for URI
- 6. Medication Management for People with Asthma (>=75%; Age 5+)

#### Menu Measures (Pick 3; Selection in Mid 2018)

- 1. Follow Up Care for ADHD Medication Management (Continuation & Maintenance Phase)
- 2. Adolescent Well-Care Visits\*
- 3. Appropriate Testing for Pharyngitis\*
- 4. Chlamydia Screening (Age 16-24; previously 16-20)

Performance Targets for 2019 are Rising! Overall, the Network will Need to Continue to Improve on Following 3 Measures to Earn Applicable Incentives!

- Well Child Visits within First 15 Months of Life [Target increased 3.1% points to 88.3% | CHN Rate: 88.1%]
- Chlamydia Screening [Target increased 10.9% points to 44.0% | CHN Rate: 38.8%]
- Medication Management for People with Asthma [Target increased 7.7% points to 44.3% | CHN Rate: 40.3%]

## **American Board of Pediatrics Maintenance of Certification (MOC)**

# Instruction Guide to Receive MOC Credits via CHN

Who is Eligible for American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) MOC Part 4 Credit?

- - **CHN Clinical Quality Committee Representative**
  - Provider has attended ≥ 4 CHN Clinical Quality Committee meetings during the MOC project cycle date range (found on each project's associated Attestation Form)
  - · Provider has completed mandatory CHN education
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### **Non-CHN Clinical Quality Committee Representative**

- Documentation (e.g. minutes) showing the provider attended ≥ 4 office meetings during the MOC project cycle date range where CHN Clinical Quality Committee strategies related to the applicable MOC project were discussed [documentation must be provided with application]
- Provider has completed mandatory CHN education
