Top Recommendations & Tactics to Inform Quality Improvement in 2022

HPV Vaccination

HPV Vaccination Rates 37% Lower than MCV/Tdap

Key Tactics:

- o Consider recommending the HPV vaccine at age 9 to help patients attain higher antibody levels and start conversations earlier for hesitant parents.
- o If vaccine refused at age 9, offer HPV vaccine bundled with other age 13 vaccinations as a standard of care.

Insights:

- HPV Vaccine rates vary dramatically between providers within each practice. Use Innovaccer CIN Quality Performance Dashboard to view your vaccinnation rates compared to your colleagues' rates within your practice.
