Innovaccer is the population health management technology platform utilized by CHN as we transition from Evolent Vision. Innovaccer offers several solutions for different needs including InNote and Patient 360 (P360).

InNote allows point-of-care workflow integration, specifically helpful for pre-visit planning and for use at the point of care. InNote concisely and efficiently communicates a patient profile including gaps in care/recommended care, recent acute visits including inpatient admissions, ED visits, and Urgent Care visits, and past and future specialty visits. 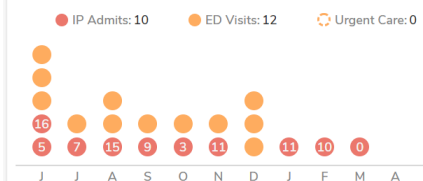

### CHN is Developing a Full Scale Innovaccer Deployment Plan

- Targeted Timeline: Mid-May through August/September 2020
  - Deployment Process:
    - Staged Implementation Including ~1-2 Practices Per Week
- Note: Implementation Depends on EMR Data Feed Being Fully Implemented
- Pre-Deployment Meeting with Practice Manager and IT Contact (If Necessary) to Test Install Process
  - Virtual On-Boarding Education & Deployment
  - Weekly CHN PR Touch Base with Practice/Clinical Manager to Collect Feedback and Address Questions or Concerns
