Understanding Risk Adjustment – What it is, Why is it Important, and How to Influence to Improve Your Practice's Risk Adjusted Cost Performance!



Our network's cost performance within value-based agreements is dependent on risk adjusted cost.

Risk Adjusted Cost =  $\frac{\text{Total Cost}}{\text{Risk Score}}$ 

Total Cost
Risk Score

A higher risk score
(i.e. more medical
complexity) lowers your
risk adjusted cost.



How Can I Influence My Practice's Risk Score to Ensure It Appropriately Reflects the Risk of My Patients?

Ensure your risk score is accurate by coding all diagnoses (at the appropriate acuity) managed during your clinic visits.

Risk scores are based exclusively on diagnoses <u>included</u> <u>on claims</u>. Problem list diagnoses are <u>not included</u>.

## Q1 Reports Have Been Distributed to Your CHN Committee Members

CHN Quarterly Cost & Utilization Reports were introduced in the <u>September 2017</u>
<u>CHN Committee Key Takeaways</u> as a way to inform practices of their cost and utilization performance. The most actionable information within these reports are the "High Cost & High ER/Inpatient Utilization Patient Lists".

Your practice is asked to review the patients and/or families included to assess whether further engagement with your practice's medical home is necessary (i.e. access to care, management of chronic conditions, etc.).
