Final Blue KC 2017 Incentive Performance Results Are In – Network Achieves Approximately 95% of Available Incentive!



- Network improved significantly in BMI (+39% points), HPV (+13% points), and URI (-5% pts)!
- 11 practices exceeded targeted in ALL applicable clinical quality measures!

Quality Improvement Insights and Learnings – Learn How Your Practice Can Improve!

Follow-Up Care for Children Prescribed ADHD Medication - Key Learnings & Insights

- Review & share the measure definition with providers in your practice (see [ADHD Follow Up Care Overview Slide Deck](#)).
-  Schedule both the initial ADHD visit and the 30 day follow up visit at the same time!
-  Schedule follow up visit within 30 days before family leaves the clinic. Require an in-person visit to continue ADHD medication.
- Utilize nurse practitioners for the 30 day follow up visit.
- Avoid long ADHD medication holidays if possible.
- Important Insight: Telehealth visits are not considered for compliance.

Quarterly CHN Clinical Integration Quality and Engagement Report

Summary of Changes Since Last Published in May 2018: The network continues to improve in HPV immunizations (up 2% points), depression screening (up 4% points), and tobacco screening (up 6% points).
