

Top Takeaways from the January 2018 CHN Committee Meeting

Updated Blue KC Medical Home Program – What Measures are Included for 2018 and What's It Worth!?

The Blue KC program has had some important updates for 2018, including:

- Patient Experience and PCMH Performance are <u>no longer incentive measures</u>. Both categories are now <u>assumed and expected requirements</u> for participation.
- Incentives have increased focused on Clinical Quality and Cost/Utilization Performance

- **PCP Practice Coordination:** Alice will help facilitate collaboration and coordination between patients, practice, and Cigna programs (if applicable) for more effective care.
- Ongoing Referral and Coordination with Cigna: On Disease Management, High Risk Patient Care Plans, etc.
- **Transitions of Care:** Alice will support post inpatient discharge follow up, medication reconciliation, etc.
