

# Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life

- **Measure Definition**

This measure includes both the **current** Well-Child Visits for First 15 Months measure and a **new** Well-Child Visits 15 to 30 Months measure

- **Eligible Population**

- WC Visits First 15 Months: Patients who turned 15 months old during the measurement year
    - WC Visits 15 to 30 Months: Patients who turned 30 months old during the measurement year

- **Compliance**

- WC Visits First 15 Months: Six or more well-child visits by 15 months of age (minimum of 14 days between visits)
    - WC Visits 15 to 30 Months: Two or more well-child visits between 15 to 30 months of age

- **Continuous Enrollment Period**

- WC Visits First 15 Months: 31 days through 15 months of age.
    - WC Visits 15 to 30 Months: 15 months plus 1 day through 30 months of age
    - Both: No more than one gap in enrollment of up to 45 days during the continuous enrollment period.

# Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life

- **AAP Bright Futures Recommended Visit Schedule for Patients 0-15 Months**

1. 3-5 Day Visit

\*\*A 2-Week Visit May Be Added for Clinical Reasons but May Not Count Toward 6 Visits Due to 2 Week Minimum

2. By 1 Month Visit (Recommended at 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Week of Life; Minimum of 2 Weeks After 3-5 Day Visit)

3. 2 Month Visit

4. 4 Month Visit

5. 6 Month Visit

6. 9 Month Visit

7. 12 Month Visit

8. 15 Month Visit (Typically Performed After 15 Months Old)

# Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life

- **Key Quality Improvement Strategies for Well Child Visits 0-15 Months**



- Schedule the “By 1 Month Visit” the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Week of Life to Ensure 14 Day Minimum is Exceeded
- Schedule the Next Recommended Visit Before the Family Leaves the Office. If Possible, Schedule the Next Visit When the Family Arrives and is Waiting in the Waiting Room. May Consider Scheduling Multiple Future Preventive Visits.
- Have Physicians and Care Team Remind Families About the Importance of the First 30 Month Well Visits During the Visit
- Send Appointment Reminders (Via Email, Phone, Text, Calls)
- Utilize Portal Well Visit 15 Month Graduated Compliance Report



# Well Visit 15 Month Graduated Compliance Portal Report

## Why Important:

- View well visit count and well visit dates for all 15 month and younger patients
- Compare expected number of well child visits to actual
- Features an “On Track” column to help facilitate & target outreach

- Features “On Track to Meet Measure” Column to Inform Patient “Compliance Status” as the Patient Ages
- Displays Date of Every Well Child Visit for Each Patient

Well Visits Must Be At Least 14 Days Apart to Count Toward Compliance!

# Well-Child Visits 15 to 30 Months of Life

- **AAP/Bright Future Recommended Visit Schedule for Patients 15-30 Months**

1. 15 Month Well Visit (Assuming Occurs After 15 Months of Age)
2. 18 Month Well Visit
3. 24 Month Well Visit
4. 30 Month (Typically Performed After 30 Months Old)

4 Opportunities to Achieve 2 or More Visits Necessary for 15-30 Month Measure Compliance

# Well-Child Visits 15 to 30 Months of Life

- **Key Quality Improvement Strategies for Well Child Visits 15-30 Months**



- Schedule the Next Recommended Visit Before the Family Leaves the Office. If Possible, Schedule the Next Visit When the Family Arrives and is Waiting in the Waiting Room. May Consider Scheduling Multiple Future Preventive Visits.
- Have Physicians and Care Team Remind Families About the Importance of the First 30 Month Well Visits During the Visit
- Send Appointment Reminders (Via Email, Phone, Text, Calls)

Tactics & Strategies Mirror Many of the Well-Child 15 Month Measure!
