Summary of Changes Since Last Published November 2017: CHN Continues to Improve in HPV Immunizations (Up 2% points), Depression Screening (Up 8.5% points), BMI Percentile/Nutritional Counseling (Up 7-8% Points), and Tobacco Screening (Up 7% Points)! 3-6 Year Old Well Visits & 15-Month Well Visits Also Increased 1-2% Points

Inappropriate Treatment for Upper Respiratory Infection – New Learnings Providers Need to Know!

After a detailed review, 2 new learning were identified to improve performance on the "Appropriate Treatment for Children with Upper Respiratory Infection" measure.

Lesson Learned:

- 1 New: Ensure competing diagnoses are "linked" to claim (if not included on claim, payer will not exclude patient)
- 2 New: Nonsuppurative otitis media diagnoses are not competing diagnoses since they do not warrant an antibiotic.
