

# STICK IT TO HPV - Prevent cancer

Vaccinate your children today to prevent them from contracting HPV-related cancers later. The HPV vaccine protects against cancers caused by the human papillomavirus. The vaccine is FDA-approved to be given at age 9, and recommended for preteen boys and girls at age 11 or 12.
